



Good Samaritan School Enrollment Policy

Academic

Some students may be admitted pending an evaluation of readiness at the beginning or end of the first quarter.

Behavior

Students with a continued history of behavior problems in other schools may not be admitted.

Special Education Assistance

Good Samaritan School may enroll students with special needs when:

- Full support of private and public assistance is in place.
- The Head of School and Staff concur that the school is able to implement objectives written for the student.
- The service of a shadow/aide that may be required is hired.
(This aide is paid for by the student's family).

Termination

A student may be asked to withdraw if the Financial Policy is not heeded or if a student poses a health or safety threat to others. The Head of School and/or Board of Trustees may use their discretion if there are any special circumstances.

Withdrawals

After attendance has started, a written notice is required two weeks before withdrawal. If withdrawal must be immediate, a billing will be made for a two week period. The June 2011 tuition prepayment is forfeited. It cannot be used to pay a last month's tuition.
